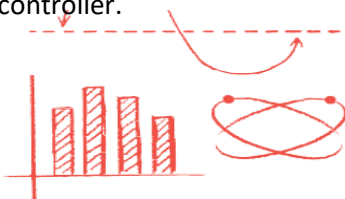


Lecture
